

Litter Procedure

Procedure Agreed May 2018. To be reviewed May 2020.



Aims:

To visibly improve the appearance and image of the school/centre by picking up litter.

To encourage a sense of personal pride and responsibility.

To reduce the amount of litter on the site.

What staff, children and parents/carers can do:

Everton Nursery School and Family Centre are committed to improving the school/centre by keeping the environment litter free. Working together, children, staff and the local community will notice improvements through the following:

- Children are actively encouraged to take responsibility for aspects of the school/centre such as keeping the environment litter free.
- Children work with staff on litter patrols.
- Children are actively encouraged to maintain and care for the outdoors including plants.
- The environment is improved by being promoted through the curriculum and ECO work.
- Children, parents/carers, staff and the local community are encouraged to take a sense of personal pride and responsibility for the school/centre grounds.
- Litters bins are provided at the front of the school/centre and emptied regularly.

This procedure was reviewed by a group of five Governors on behalf of the Curriculum, Children and Family Committee on Thursday 10th May 2018 and ratified at the Governing Body meeting of Everton Nursery School and Family Centre Governing Body on Thursday 17th May 2018.
