

What is a parent governor and how you can become one

Parent Governors are an important part of our Board of Governors. It is a rewarding role. They are a vital representative voice and often add a lot to the skills and knowledge within the Board of Governors.

We support all Governors with a full induction. There is also access to regular training and online support

Parent Governors are elected when a vacancy becomes available. They are elected by parents from our school community.

To qualify as a Parent Governor we ask for nominations from parents with children at Everton Nursery School and Family Centre. If no nominations are forthcoming, we will accept nominations from any parent who has a child at a Liverpool School.

We will formally advertise when a vacancy becomes available, making clear the skills that the Governing Body need. If we receive more than one nomination a parent election process will take place.

Our current Parent Governors are Vicky Richardson and Pauline Melia. We have 1 vacancy.

We are currently looking for another parent governor.

We currently need governors with skills in HR and finance but most importantly, we need governors who are interested in how the Centre is supporting children and parents. Parent governors are valued members of the governing body and you will find it a rewarding role. We do provide any training that you might need.
