

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Children, Families and Curriculum Committee



Aims:

- To promote, share and acknowledge high quality integrated education with care for children from two to five years who attend the Nursery School.
- To ensure the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Framework is embedded within the integrated education with care of the Nursery School.
- To review and monitor practice, provision and the progress of children with Special, Educational Needs and Disability.
- To review and monitor practice, provision and the progress of disadvantaged children including those who access Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) and Free School Meals (FSM).
- To review and monitor safeguarding and child protection practice and provision. To review and monitor the progress of children who are supported through 'Early Help', Section 17 Child In Need (CIN), Section 47 Child Protection (CP) and Children Looked After (CLA).
- To evaluate the practice and provision of the Nursery School through a range of self-evaluation mechanisms including through the use of self-evaluation forms (SEF's).
- To monitor and review the Nursery School's School Development Plan (SDP).
- To monitor and scrutinise the impact of action research within the school/centre.
- To scrutinise and challenge pupil progress and achievement.
- To review and monitor the Nursery School's admissions and attendance.

Objectives

- To meet termly with specific working groups as required.
- To undertake monitoring of children's learning across the Nursery School 2-5's.
- To disseminate good practice.
- To support parents/carers in understanding how the Nursery School encourages, supports and deepens their child's learning.
- To provide up to date information to the Governing Body of evaluation procedures i.e. the SDP and SEF's.
- To develop creative and effective ways to evaluate services on-site.
- To inform the Governing Body about any research that is undertaken at Everton Nursery School and Family Centre (research agreement to be completed before any research is started at Everton Nursery School and Family Centre).
- To review curriculum and other relevant policies/procedures as identified in the Governing Body timetable.
