LITERACY

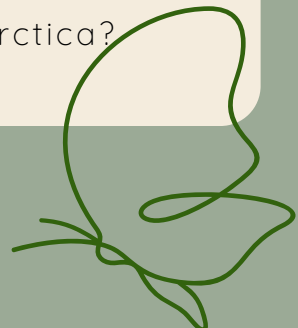
Active drama - moving like a penguin
